- Row 1: A# Bb (0), Bb (1234), Bb (134), Cb (234), Cb (124), D# Eb (14), Eb (24)
- Row 2: Fb (4), F# Gb (23), Gb (12), G# Ab (1), Ab (2), A# Bb (0), Bb (24)
- Row 3: Cb (4), C# Db (23), Db (12), D# Eb (1), Eb (2), Fb (0), F# Gb (23), Gb (12)
- Row 4: G# Ab (1), Ab (2), A# Bb (0), Bb (12), Cb (1), C# Db (2), Db (0)
- Row 5: D# Eb (1), Eb (2), Fb (0), F# Gb (23), Gb (12), G# Ab (1), Ab (2)
- Row 6: A# Bb (0), Bb (12), Cb (1), C# Db (2), Db (0), D# Eb (1)
- Row 7: Eb (2), Fb (0), F# Gb (23), Gb (12), G# Ab (1), Ab (2), A# Bb (0)

*In some cases, 12 should be substituted with 3
